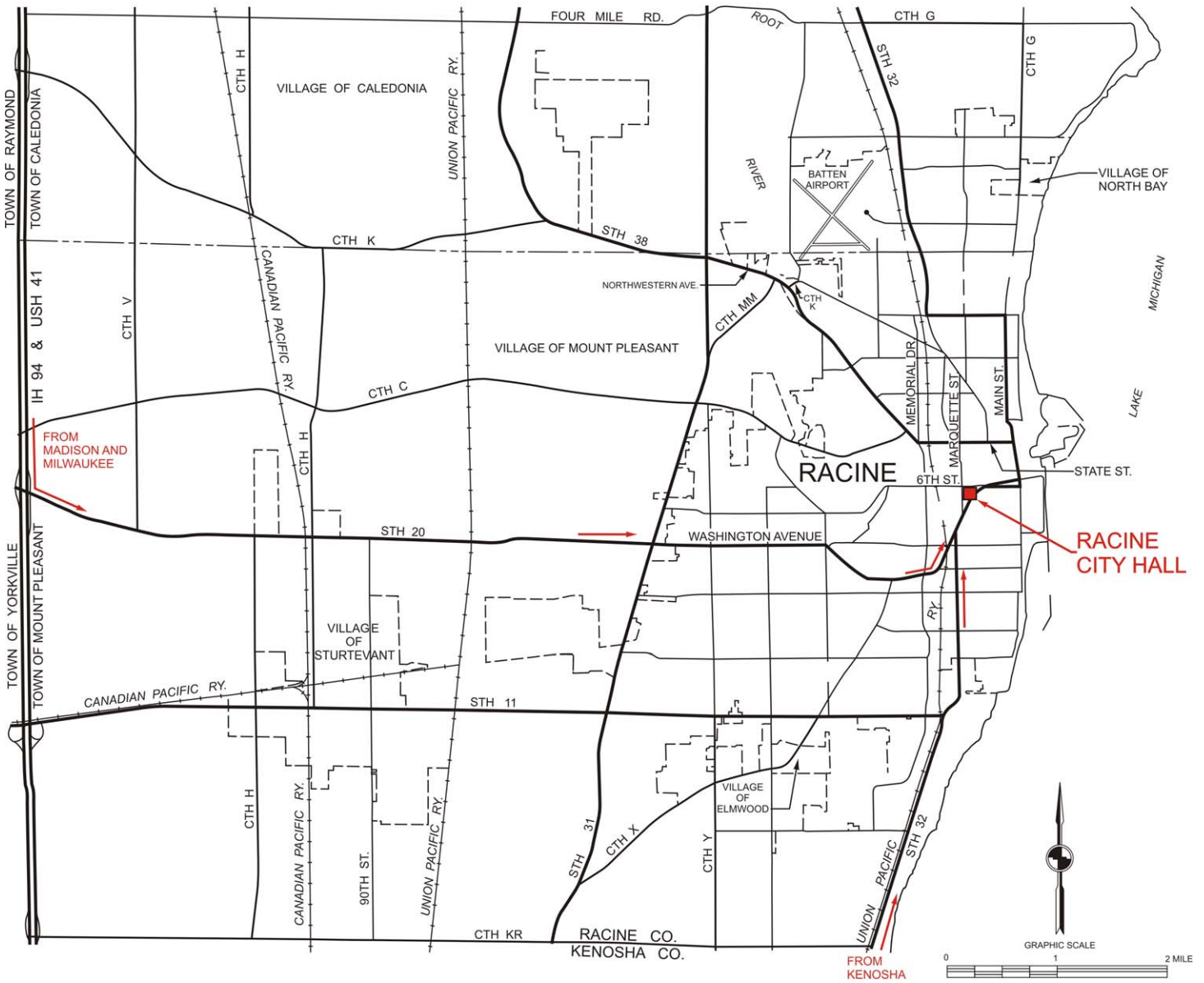

## RACINE CITY HALL 730 WASHINGTON AVENUE RACINE

**Directions:** The Racine City Hall is located on the north side of Washington Avenue at the intersection of 6th Street and Center Street in the City of Racine. From Madison and Milwaukee, take IH 94 south to the exit at STH 20 (Exit 333), go east on STH 20 and Washington Avenue about 9.0 miles to City Hall. From Kenosha, take STH 32 (Sheridan Road and Racine Street) north to Washington Avenue and go northeast on Washington Avenue approximately 0.5 mile to City Hall. The entrance to the City Hall visitor parking lot is located on the north side of Washington Avenue between 8th Street and Center Street. Additional parking is available in the lower level City Hall parking lot.

## DIRECTIONS FROM RACINE CITY HALL TO STATE STREET DEPOT

1. Exit City Hall parking lot to the north and turn west on Sixth Street.
2. At first traffic signal, turn right (north) on Marquette Street
3. At 2<sup>nd</sup> traffic signal, turn left (west) on State Street
4. Just before railroad tracks, turn left (south) into cul-de-sac at Racine Metro Transit Center
5. Depot is ahead on the right.

1:	Start out going WEST on WI-38 / STATE ST toward N MEMORIAL DR. Continue to follow WI-38 W.	4.0 miles
2:	Turn SLIGHT LEFT onto CR-K W / NORTHWESTERN AVE.	5.0 miles
3:	Turn RIGHT onto E FRONTAGE RD.	0.1 miles
4:	Merge onto I-94 W / US-41 N via the ramp on the LEFT.	18.4 miles
5:	Take I-43 N toward GREEN BAY.	0.4 miles
6:	Take the KILBOURN AVE exit- EXIT 72C- toward CIVIC CENTER.	0.3 miles
